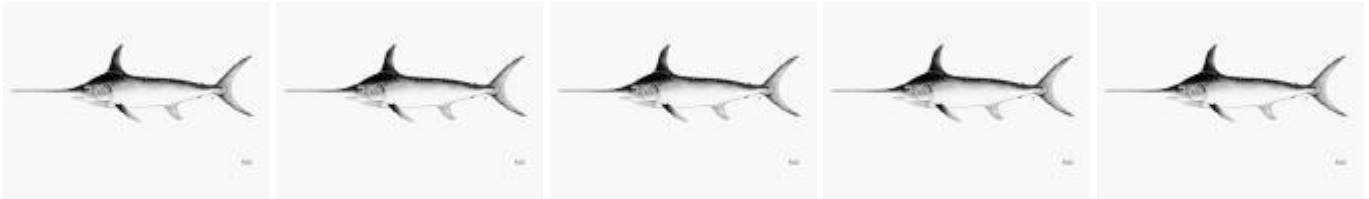

## FISHING REPORT

A good fishing trend has been developing over the past few days since last weekends west wind blowout. While the near shore ocean anglers enjoyed the flat seas it made drifting over the reefs almost impossible as boats were blown eastward. Spanish Mackerel, a few sailfish and many mutton snapper have been biting over the rock reefs and more fish should be getting active as the weather warms up.

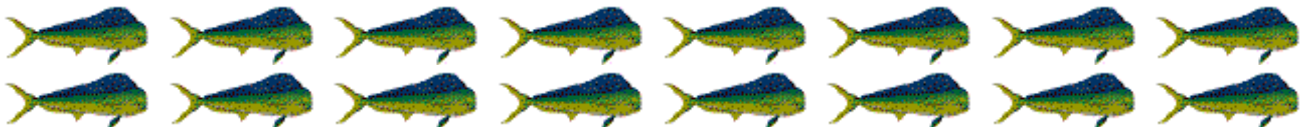
Mutton snapper have been biting in water around the 90-125 foot depths. Favorite baits for these snapper have been whole dead sardines, cut mullet, bonito strips and squid. Fish the rock reefs and anchor in position if you have to.

Spanish Mackerel have been taking baits from beach surf casters and boaters out to about 90 feet of water. Gold and Silver spoons have taken a bunch of these fish that have been running the tide changes at all the inlets and piers. The Juno Pier has been a hot spot and the Lake Worth Pier has had a good showing of these fish as well. Surf casters are filling five gallon buckets from the beaches of Hobe Sound.

Sailfish action continues to be good from the Lake Worth Inlet northward to Ft. Pierce.

The vessels that can get out during the rough water periods are hooking into good numbers of these sport game fish. If you are looking for a trophy mount now is the time to charter an experienced crew and have them take you and your guests offshore for some tight line reel action. You will not be disappointed in your guest.

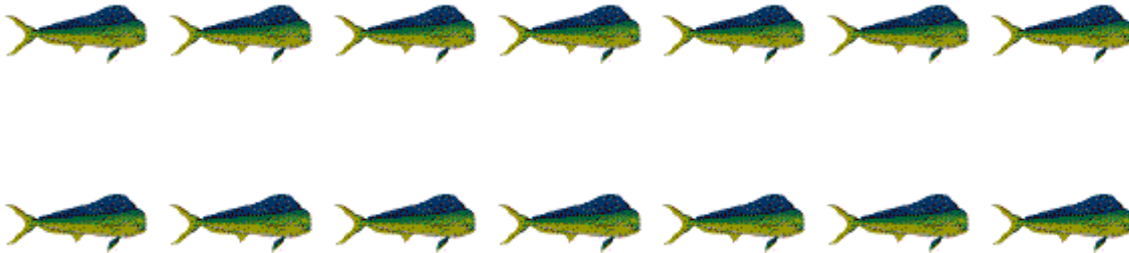
# June 24 Sat. (Tentative Date) **Teach Kids to Fish Day**
